

2020-21 Natural Disaster Resilience Program – Quick Eligibility Check

To be eligible to apply, all requirements outlined in this document must be met. Applications close 12 pm, Friday 16 October 2020.

By applying, it is expected that you have understood all information in the [Guidelines for Applicants](#) and [Sample Funding Agreement](#)

SECTION 1. My organisation:

- is willing to sign and comply with the requirements in the NDRP Funding Agreement (refer [Sample Funding Agreement](#))
- is involved in Emergency Management
- does not have any current non-compliant NDRP, NBMP or AWARE grants
- is incorporated and has an ABN
- is not applying for funds to respond to, or recover from, an event
- meets all DFES and SEMC legislated requirements
- has undertaken a project risk assessment for the delivery of this project
- will comply with any relevant codes and Acts, including the Australian Government Building and Construction WHS Accreditation Scheme, and comply with the Building Code 2016

SECTION 2. My project:

- meets at least one of the following criteria (tick all that apply)
 - addresses extreme, high or medium risks identified as part of the SEMC's [State Risk Project](#)
 - addresses capability gaps identified through the SEMC's [Emergency Preparedness Reporting](#) process
 - is informed by other objective, scientifically validated and documented analysis
- aligns with at least one [National Strategy for Disaster Resilience](#) priority
- delivers sustained disaster resilience or mitigation, and will reduce future disaster response or recovery spend
- will directly benefit the WA community
- serves the public interest and does not provide a commercial advantage
- does not have a more appropriate funding source or should be delivered by a more appropriate organisation
- delivers sustained resilience, not temporary outputs. (If a research project, attach a letter of support from a relevant Hazard Management Agency stating their direct interest in the findings of your project)
- has realistic timeframes and milestones
- has realistic outcomes and a credible budget
- will not commence before the Funding Agreement is signed, or before the 1 January 2021 and will commence prior to 31 December 2021
- will apply a [Creative Commons](#) license (if relevant)
- has endorsement from the Chief Executive Officer (or equivalent) and Chief Financial Officer (or equivalent)
- is consistent with the policies and intentions of both the Australian and Western Australian Governments

SECTION 3. My application is requesting:

- NDRP funding between \$10,000 and \$250,000 (no GST applied)
- no more than 50% of the project's total cost
- project funding to address at least one natural hazard:
 - bushfire cyclone earthquake flood heatwave storm tsunami
- project funding for an activity that won't require ongoing NDRP funding to be sustainable
- project funding for an activity that does not deliver business as usual, or any expected responsibilities of my organisation (such as standard exercises or training), including maintenance, upkeep or operating costs

If you meet all requirements you are eligible to apply. Please complete and return the Application Form.
